

ICBR Point Information (revised 09/23/25)

All breed classes will be the same with how the points are awarded.
American Bullies is the only breed with varieties.

Classes for all breeds (minus varieties)

- 3-6 Month puppy (Practice class/No points awarded)
- 6-9 Month puppy
- 9-12 Month puppy
- 1-2 Year young adult
- 2-3 Year adult
- 3-up senior

1st Place – 10 Points

2nd Place – 5 Points

3rd Place – No points given

All first-place winners (except the 3-6mth) will compete for best male/best female

Best Male / Best Female – 20 Points (Considered a Major win)

Best of Winners (winner from BM/BF) – 20 Points (this is only for additional breeds not including the American Bully, French Bulldog or Exotic Bully)

Best of Breed –The win goes towards Royal Breed Winner for the year.
(Best of Winners, Ch, GrCh compete)

Best in Show - Best in show wins will go toward the end of year

Royal Best in Show Winner

(The dog that has the most BIS wins at the end of the year)

Each class above needs at least 1 other dog in the class for competition to obtain points. If no other dog, no points are obtained.

ICBR Point Information (revised 09/23/25)

To obtain the championship title – A total of 160 points, including 3 major wins under 2 different judges.

Champion class wins – 20 Points

To obtain a Gold Grand Champion Title – A total of 5 champion wins for a total of 100 points (5 wins) Must have 1 other champion in the class to obtain points

Grand Champion Levels -

Platinum Grand Champion (10 Grand Champion wins with at least 1 other dog in class)

End of year award and added into the ICBR Hall of Fame

Royal Breed Winner – Each best of breed wins goes towards the end of year award and title of “ROYAL BREED WINNER 2025” given each year at the ICBR Nationals.

Variety Breeds: American Bully, Exotic Bully, French Bulldog

American bully/Exotic bully show in Standard until 9 months of age

- 3-6 Month puppy (Practice class/ No points awarded)
- 6-9 Month puppy
- 9-12 Month puppy
- 1-2 Year young adult
- 2-3 Year adult
- 3-up Senior

1st Place – 10 Points

2nd Place – 5 Points

3rd Place – No points given

Best Male / Best Female of each variety – 20 Points (Considered a Major win)

Best of Variety (Standard, Pocket, Extreme, & Classic) – 10 Points

Best of Winners - 10 Points

Best of Breed – Win goes towards Royal Breed Winner for the year.
(Best of Winners, Ch, GrCh compete)

Best in Show - Best in show wins will go toward the end of year

Royal Best in Show Winner

(The dog that has the most BIS wins at the end of the year)

ICBR Point Information (revised 09/23/25)

Each class above needs at least 1 other dog in the class for competition to obtain points. If no other dog, no points are obtained.

To obtain the championship title – A total of 160 points, including 3 major wins under 2 different judges:

AMERICAN BULLY only (Female and Male are now separate

To obtain a Grand Champion Title A total of 5 Champion wins

To obtain a Gold Grand Champion Title – A total of 5 GrChampion wins

Must have 1 other champion in the class to obtain points

Grand Champion Levels -

Platinum Grand Champion (10 Grand Champion wins with at least 1 other dog in class)

Royal Breed Winner – Each best of breed wins goes towards the end of year award and title of “ROYAL BREED WINNER 2025” given each year at the ICBR Nationals.

BEST OF BREED- Win goes towards Royal Breed Winner for the Year.
(Best of Variety, Ch, GrCh. Compete)

****** Each class above needs at least 1 other dog in the class for competition to obtain points. If no other dog, no points are obtained.

To obtain the Championship Title - A total of 160 points, including 3 major wins under 2 different Judges.
Champion Class wins -20 points.

To obtain a Gold Grand Champion Title- A total of 5 champion wins for a total of 100 points (5 wins) Must have 1 other Champion in class to obtain points.

Grand Champion Levels- Platinum Grand Champion (10 Grand Champion wins with at least 1 other Grand Champion in class).

BEST IN SHOW- Win goes towards Overall Best in Show Winner of the Year.

End of the Year Award and added into the ICBR Hall of Fame.

Royal Breed Winner - Each Best of Breed wins goes towards the end of the year Award and Title of ***ROYAL BREED WINNER 2021"** given each year at the ICBR NATIONALS
